## Turkey Hunting Weekend

This weekend is for women hunters who want to build the confidence needed to hunt turkeys on their own. Topics for the weekend will include: turkey habitat and behavior; gear and equipment; scouting, safety, ethics and firearm handling; caring for, cleaning, plucking and cooking wild birds. Participants will have the opportunity to learn turkey calls, pattern a shotgun, put the turkeys to roost, call them in and participate in a mock-hunt. This workshop will be held rain or shine. Attendees are encouraged (not required) to bring the shotgun they will use to hunt turkeys. A hunting license is not required, but it is strongly recommended that participants have a N.H. Hunting License or are in the process of taking a Hunter Safety Education Course (reminder: spring turkey hunting season in New Hampshire opens May 3, 2010). Cost: \$295, includes instruction, materials, use of equipment, meals and 2 nights lodging. Limit: 14 participants.

## IMPORTANT BEYOND BOW TURKEY HUNTING REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**CONFIRMATION:** Upon being registered, you will be sent a written confirmation that you have been accepted to the program, along with an information packet. If the program is full you will be put on a waiting list until March 24. If no space becomes available, your check will be returned or your credit card will be refunded at that time

**REGISTRATION:** Registered participants must check-in on Friday, April 23, between 5:00 and 6:00 pm. After you park your vehicle in the parking lot (where it will stay for the entire weekend) and settle into your room, you are invited to dinner at 6:00 pm.

**LODGING/MEALS:** The Edgewood Lodge offers spacious rooms with two double beds. Accommodations are for two participants per room. Linens will be provided. All rooms have private bathrooms. **EQUIPMENT:** Participants are encouraged to bring their own shotgun (if it is one they normally use), warm clothes (layers for early morning and evening), hunting gear or camouflage clothing they already have, rain gear, waterproof boots, sunglasses, Chapstick, camo face nets, gloves, flashlight, water bottle, bug spray, camera, fanny pack or small backpack, seat cushion (optional), notebook and pen, personal clothing and toiletries.

**HUNTING LICENSE:** A hunting license is not required, but it is strongly recommended that you either have a N.H. Hunting License or are in the process of taking a Hunter Safety Education Course.

### **DIRECTIONS TO WOODBOUND INN:**

**From the East or West:** There are three main east/west routes to bring you into our area of the Monadnock Region. Rt. 101 to Rt. 202 in Peterborough. Rt. 124 to Rt. 202 in Jaffrey or Rt. 119 to Rt. 202 in Rindge. (See below for continued directions)

**From the North (Peterborough and Jaffrey):** From Peterborough follow Rt. 202 South into Jaffrey (Route 202 turns right, then left through downtown Jaffrey, so watch for the signs) from the traffic lights in Jaffrey travel south approximately 3 miles. Watch for the blue state highway sign on the right for the Woodbound Inn; take the next left onto South Woodbound Road. Proceed about .2 miles and turn left onto the Woodbound Road. The Inn is 1.8 miles on the left.

**From the South (Rindge, NH and MA):** From the state line follow Rt. 202 North into Rindge, approximately 3.75 miles to the intersection of Rt. 119. Go straight at the traffic light, continuing approximately one mile. Watch for a blue state highway sign on the right for the Woodbound Inn. Take the next right turn onto south Woodbound Road. Proceed about .2 mile and turn left onto Woodbound Road. The Inn is 1.8 miles on the left.
