SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE IS May 12, 2023. To be considered for a scholarship, you must submit a completed scholarship application, including: this scholarship application, with your written statement and your \$25 application deposit. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated.

Scholarship Application Deposit: \$25 (applies toward the registration fee if you attend, will be refunded if you do not receive a scholarship and choose not to attend.) **Make check payable to: NH Wildlife Trust.** If you are not selected for a scholarship, you will receive a refund of your deposit. You can still register for the weekend and pay the full cost.

Notification: Scholarship applicants will receive communication regarding their status by June 5, 2023. If you decide not to attend for any reason, please notify us by July 3, 2023.

IMPORTANT: You must still register for the event after being notified that you have received a scholarship. Download the Fall BOW Registration Form (available at nhbow.com).

Being awarded a scholarship does NOT guarantee that you are accepted to the Fall Weekend or placement in specific classes. Space is limited and the program fills up fast.
